For the 2016 – 2017 school year, leadership will include, but not limited to: Drum Major(s), Assistant Drum Major(s), Woodwind Captain, Brass Captain, Color Guard Captain(s), Battery Captain, Pit Captain(s), and Section Leaders. To be considered, you must have exemplary attendance and behavior, demonstrated leadership, maturity, and have the ability to fulfill expectations at a high standard of excellence.

Characteristics of a successful and effective leader

- They are highly responsible and reliable
- They are dedicated to having the ensemble succeed
- They support and communicate well with the Band Director(s), staff, and the membership of the band
- They know how to teach and assist other members of the band in a positive manner
- They have the ability to inspire the band in performance

The duties of the leaders include (but are not limited to):

• Support the Director and instructional staff, with the utmost dedication, devotion and loyalty

• Maintain a strong dedication to the entire program

• Serve every student with passion and desire to ensure a positive experience for everyone

• Act as a liaison between the Director, staff and students

• Get the band out to the proper area and prepared to begin rehearsal

• Help rehearsals run smoothly and productively

• Communicate information to members before, during, and/or after rehearsals

• Set the standard and help enforce discipline and conduct for the members of the band to follow

• Organize room clean up details as directed

• Work with new members to help them feel a part of the team/family

- Tutor individual members to improve skills
- Monitor behavior in the stands at
- competitions and football games
- Help foster the goals of teamwork and excellence with the band
- Set a high standard for performance and personal integrity
- Communicate with the Director and staff regarding specific issues concerning the group

Drum Major(s) –The Drum Major(s) leads the Marching Band during all field show, parade activities, and school/community events. The Drum Major must know how to conduct and help run rehearsals.

The duties of the Drum Major will also include, but not limited to:

- Conduct the field show and help conduct the pep band
- Assist Director and staff during rehearsals
- Take band through warm-up exercises
- Monitor section leader effectiveness
- Help get all needed equipment to and from rehearsal area/performances
- Represent the band at awards ceremonies and special functions

The Assistant Drum Major(s) duties will also include, but not limited to:

- Assume all responsibilities in the absence of the Drum Major
- Help conduct the field show (if needed)
- Same expectations as head Drum Major

Captain/Section Leader – This is the person who will lead their respective section, from a disciplinary, marching, and musical perspective.

Captain/Section Leader duties will also include, but not limited to:

• Monitor section attendance and participation at rehearsals/performances and report absences and/or concerns to Secretary, staff and/or Director

- Supervise their respective section's drill maneuvers and dot books
- Organize and run sectional rehearsals as needed
- Monitor student performance of all show music and responsibilities
- Give memorization test to section members
- Organize weekly instrument maintenance checks
- Tutor individual members to improve skills

Audition Requirements for Leadership:

- Current Teacher recommendations (separate form available on "Downloads" section of website)
- Essay explaining, "Why You Would Make a Successful Leader"
- Conducting (for Drum Majors only) of: wind warm ups, and all of the upcoming fall field show
- Interview with Director(s), staff, and/or previous leaders
